

Exploring Digital Resources

The first few courses in the ADL program are to introduce you to many of the tools you can use to make your environment more digitally inclined like AI. Now, it is your turn to explore and discover tools specific to your needs in your classroom or place of employment.

Purpose: Discover and evaluate new digital tools that could enhance your classroom or workplace environment.

Requirements:

1. Select five digital tools (websites, platforms, or apps) that you have never used before
 - Exclude commonly used tools like Google products or Canva
 - You may include one AI tool, but it must serve a specific purpose rather than general use
2. For each tool, write a detailed analysis paragraph (12-16 sentences) that includes:
 - Your hands-on experience using the tool
 - Step-by-step documentation of how you used it
 - Specific advantages and disadvantages for your professional context
 - Practical applications in your work environment



Note: Focus on your personal experience using the tool rather than general product descriptions. Your analysis should demonstrate thorough exploration and testing of each tool's features and capabilities.

Length: Five paragraphs, 12-16 sentences each

Format: Each paragraph should be grammatically correct and include specific examples with proper APA formatting.
